Q. "Can I take money out of the Special Needs Trust for my own expenses?"

A mother recently mentioned that she had placed money in her daughter's third-party, special needs trust and now she had a personal cash flow problem. She wanted to know if she could withdraw some of those funds for her own expenses – not anything related to the care and support of her daughter. The simple answer is <u>NO</u>. Once you contribute an asset or cash transfer into the special needs trust, you can only use those funds for the child with a disability, not, for example, to pay your credit card bill or your own college tuition.
